$$\sigma_f = \sqrt{\left(\frac{\partial f}{\partial x}\sigma_x\right)^2 + \left(\frac{\partial f}{\partial y}\sigma_y\right)^2 + \left(\frac{\partial f}{\partial z}\sigma_z\right)^2} \tag{1}$$
